## DIRECTIONS

The Centre has a Travel Plan to encourage staff and visitors to travel to the Centre in a sustainable way. Parking is free for users of the Somerset Energy Innovation Centre, where possible please use allocated parking spaces. The carpark is monitored by an ANPR system and visitors are required to register their number plate on arrival. There are two electric car charging points available. The Somerset Energy Innovation Centre entrance is 2 doors along from the Induction Centre opposite the bicycle shed.

**By Road** - If you can **car share** please do.

**From the M5 J23 (Southbound):** Exit the M5 at J23, at the roundabout take the 3<sup>rd</sup> exit onto the A38. \*At the next roundabout take the first exit onto the A38 towards Bridgwater. Proceed past the Admirals Table pub and continue down the dual carriageway approx 500M and you will see the Centre on the left (grey and white building with a curved glass front). Take the turning into Woodlands Business Park and turn left at the T junction, Somerset Energy Innovation Centre car park is on left hand side.



### By Train

### By Bus

The nearest stops are located at the Express Park and the Admirals Table Inn (both located on the Bristol Road and around a 10 minute walk from the Centre). There are frequent services running to and from Taunton, Bridgwater town centre, Burnham and Wellington.
